## Beautiful Vision

Each year, the Prevention of Blindness Society of Metropolitan Washington (POB) performs on-site vision screenings for children in our program. This winter, the Vision Screeners noticed that our 4 year-old student Luciana (*name changed to maintain privacy*) had a drooping upper eyelid, a medical condition called ptosis. They sent her parents a referral, asking them to take Luciana to an eye doctor for a professional examination. Luciana's family wrote a letter to Marcy Babitz, Director of Children's Vision Screening at POB and told her they were aware of the condition but they did not have eye health insurance to cover surgery. Marcy reached out to a Pediatric Eye Surgeon at Children's Hospital who serves on the POB Board of Directors. She asked if he would consider taking on the surgery pro bono (without payment). The surgeon agreed. Luciana will undergo surgery this month. We are thrilled to have POB as a community partner as they help Luciana and fulfill their mission of healthy eye sight and healthy eyes for all children!
